LOCATION: Belton Gun Club (BGC) 153 Range Rd. Belton, SC 29627

ELIGIBILITY: Open to all, BGC membership is not required in order to attend. All BGC rules apply to all shooters and non-shooters.

ENTRIES: Entries are accepted the morning of the match. Match registration opens at 0800 hours, closes at 0815 hours with a safety review and rules of match are given. The first group is called to the firing line at 0830 hours.

ENTRY FEE: \$10.00

Rifles: .22LR ONLY

COURSES of FIRE: While the NRA allows for several different courses of fire, the matches will be 10 shots, standing* at four animals at different ranges for a total of 40 shots as follows:

COURSE of FIRE #1:

- 10 Chickens at 40 meters (43.75yds)
- 10 Pigs at 60 meters (65.62yds)
- 10 Turkeys at 77 meters (84.21yds)
- 10 Rams at 100 meters (109.36yds)

The course of fire is divided into two 5 shot strings. The shooters are directed to the line and when ready they are provided a 15 second "Ready" period before being provided 2 ½ minutes to shoot 5 shots. The animals must be shot in order starting with the left most animal. For example, if your 2nd shot hits the 3rd animal, or you reengage a missed animal it's a 2 point loss. After the time period has expired, competitors are provided a short break followed by non-shooters resetting targets facing the opposite direction (all shooters will rotate target resets). Then a 15 second "Ready" period followed by 2 ½ minutes to shoot the second set of animals in order from left to right. Time for shooting alibis is provided with the Range Officer providing the exact firing sequence.

COURSE of FIRE #2: This course of fire is for youth and a beginner and will be shot alongside of the full course (#1) at a reduced range. Distance and target set up will be simpler and closer. The emphasis will be on fun, not score.
